I am enjoying the Holiday Season and creating fun gifts for family and friends. This project is super simple and so fun. I took a Wal Mart frame removed the mat and used that for my quilt pattern. Using the gypsy wanderings I cut a full page of 2 inch squares from 2 different papers. Then I ran half of the papers through the Cuttlebug using holy border. I use one type of ink on the embossed areas and another ink on the debossed sides. To make the outer part of the frame even use a border color I chose 1/2 inch border of the brown paper. Cut all the squares in half creating a bunch of triangles. I used the mat to help in keeping the triangles aligned on the chipboard mat. One thing to keep in mind the triangles embossed will be smaller. The outer edge does not need to be even it will be covered with the border paper.

To make the Flower take 9 of the triangles that is red and uses those for the flower petals. To make the petals fold the petals so long edges meet in the middle. To this to six petals the other 3 triangles cut in half. Now do the same to those six petals. To make the flower arrange the bottom so the 6 petals go around in a circle you will have to cut the points down. Than arrange the smaller ones on top all around. Roll a 1/2 inch piece of paper using the twisted rose method to create the center rose.

Holly Leaves are from winter wonderland at 3 inches scrunch and ink darker color.

Add trim and you are done.
