Sweet 16 candy Necklace created by Cyndi Coon of Lovely Lula for Mixology Crafts

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

MATERIALS:

- Cricut
- Something to Celebrate cartridge
- Best Creations 12"x12" Glitter Cardstock Silvermint, Majestic Magenta, Phosphorous Purple
- 12 x 12 sheet of Chipboard
- Permanent Spray Mount
- Ranger Glossy Accents Clear
- Imaginisce Hot Rocks Purple
- Necklace Findings 3 in Silver
- Jump rings 3 in Silver
- Embroidery Floss 3, 18 inch pieces in Royal Purple, braided
- Busy Kids Plastic Necklace Clasp male and female sides in pink

STEPS:

- Using the Something to Celebrate cartridge on the Cricut cut the three candy shapes at 3 inches for the outer and inner designs out of Best Creations 12"x12" Glitter Cardstock in Silvermint, Majestic Magenta, Phosphorous Purple
- 2. Cut two each of the outer candy shape out of chipboard, sandwich the layers and glue together with permanent spray mount
- 3. Using Spray mount, attach each piece of the candy layers that where cut out of the glitter card stock
- 4. Coat front of candies with Ranger Glossy Accents Clear, while it is still wet embed purple Imaginisce Hot Rocks on to the surface
- 5. Once the front is dry (a couple of hours) coat the back and sides with clear Ranger Glossy Accents, while still wet embed silver necklace finding. Allow back and sides to dry completely
- 6. Take the 3, 18 inch pieces of embroidery floss in Royal Purple and braid them together
- Tuck them into the pink Busy Kids plastic necklace clasp and knot at the ends
- 8. Attach jump rings to the silver necklace findings and loop the jump rings through the embroidery floss, attaching as many pieces of candy as desired.
- 9. Join the clasp and you are ready to wear!
